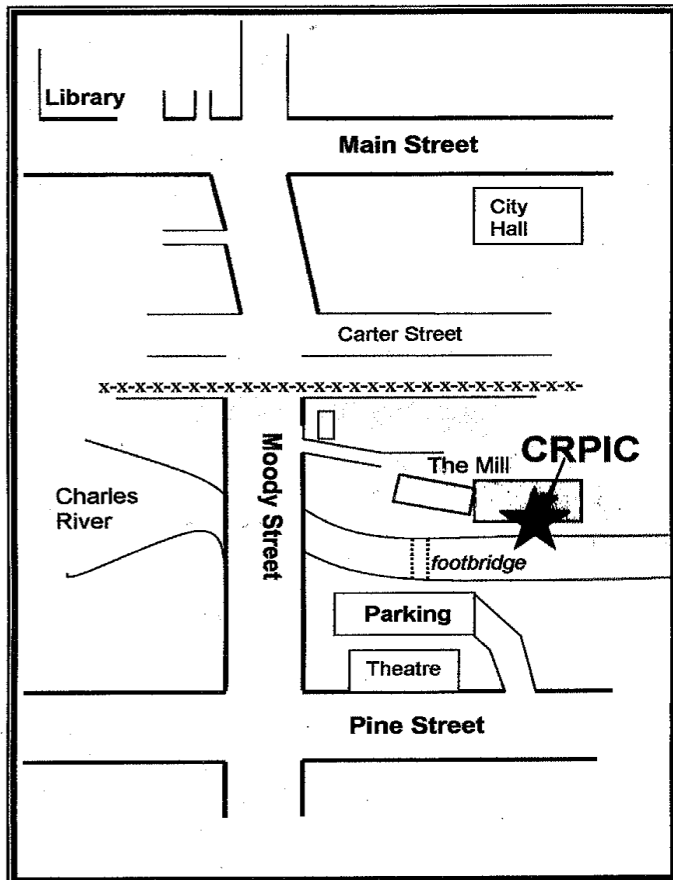
*Directions from the

WALKING:

- East on Main Street
- Right on Moody Street
- Over railroad tracks
- Left on footpath
between the river and the Mill
- Through the gate toward the
Charles River Museum of Industry
- Door is on your left just before the
museum entrance

DRIVING:

- East on Main Street
- Right on Moody Street
- Over railroad tracks
- Left on Pine Street
- Past Embassy Theatre 2 blocks
- Take left into Municipal/
Embassy parking lot
- Park car and walk toward River
- Cross the footbridge
- Head to the right and
follow signs for Internet Center
