Directions to Innovator Center:

1. Set your GPS for 11 Cooper Street to get to the Embassy Theater parking lot.
2. From Moody Street, turn onto Pine Street and pass the Embassy Theater.
3. Turn left on Cooper Street.
4. Park in the Embassy Theater lot, in the first area at the bottom of the hill. (No need to pay for parking after 6:00 pm.)
5. Walk toward the row of trees and find the sidewalk. Follow the sidewalk to the left.
6. You will locate the foot bridge on your right. Follow signs for the Public Internet Center.
7. Cross the river on the foot bridge. Turn right onto the stone path. The entrance to the Innovator Center is down a ways on your left.
